SALES TAX REFERENDUM

Shall a resolution passed by the Quarterly County court of Madison County, Tennessee, on March 20, 1972, and published in The Jackson Sun, a newspaper of general circulation in Madison County, become operative, which resolution levied a tax in the same manner and on the same privileges subject to the "Retailers' Sales Tax Act" under Section 67-3001, et seq., Tennessee Code Annotated, as the same may be amended, which are exercised within Madison County, Tennessee-such tax being levied on all such privileges at a rate, which will result in a levy of an additional tax of $\frac{1}{2}$ of 1%; which resolution provided, however, that the tax so levied shall not exceed \$7.50 on the sale or use of any single article of personal property; which resolution excepted from the tax levied thereby the sale, purchase, use consumption, or distribution of electric power or energy, natural or artificial gas, and coal and fuel oil; and which resolution provided for the collection of the tax by the Department of Revenue of the State of Tennessee?
